Fundraising is the responsibility of everyone in the club. For this club to be successful, everyone needs to participate at some point during the year. We are offering a variety of fundraising options that may help you offset your tuition costs and help the club pay for field equipment, field maintenance, tournaments, club expenses, recognition night, club picnic etc. By participating in the club fundraising, you are also helping keep the tuition costs down. Think of us as the PTA of Club Soccer. The more we raise, the more we can give back to the kids.

As a club we would encourage each family to participate in some way in all of the fundraising programs we have listed below. We know that this might be difficult for some people so in Phase 1 which benefits club and player tuition, we will offer up a buyout option. Phase 2 has been developed to help players find their own sponsor that can help pay tuition costs. This is usually a business that would like to donate using a tax id number. Phase 3 is fundraising designed for club initiatives such as field maintenance and equipment. This phase when successful, helps keep our tuition costs down. Please remember that fundraising is separate from volunteer hours. You can generate volunteer hours by helping set and run the fundraiser but one doesn't replace the other.

Several of the fundraisers will not only generate much needed funds for the club, it will also assist you in raising money that would go towards your final tuition payment. Read through the fundraising packet carefully so that you understand how the program benefits you and the club. If you are a scholarship recipient, then different rules apply. Scholarship recipients do not have the option to buy out. They must participate in all fundraising programs.
